The result: exceptionally long-lasting colours, rot-proof properties and extreme resistance to bad weather.

**A Cleangard® treatment made from fluoride nano-molecules** enables this fabric to withstand exposure to salt water. This special protection enhances the fabric's water-repellent properties, giving it unrivalled resistance to grease and stains.

**Bearing the OEKO-TEX label (awarded by an Austrian environmental institute),** Sunbrella® fabrics are produced without the use of any hazardous substances and present no danger to the health, skin or environment. Recommended by the Skin Cancer Foundation, most of the fabrics guarantee maximum protection against UV radiation (UPF 50 + = 100% of UV rays filtered).

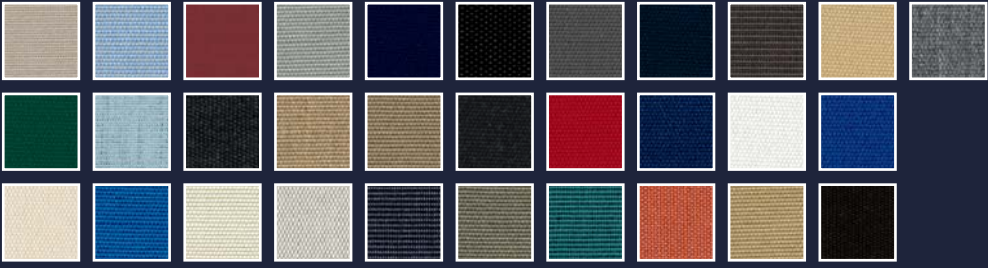
